WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, JCDA has extensive experience in dealing with airport authorities in connection with the procurement, conduct and performance of advertising concessions in various airports located throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, SPM has extensive experience in equipping and operating passenger security clearance at airports located throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, SPM owns a comprehensive solution geared at generating advertising sales utilizing its patented SecureTray System®, including SecureTrays®, SecureCarts® and DivestingTables® for utilization at passenger security checkpoint areas in airports which has been tested and approved by the TSA for installation at security checkpoint areas to improve workforce safety and to facilitate the passenger screening process; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of its agreements with airports, JCDA is granted the exclusive right to solicit and sell the use of advertising space in all or designated portions of such airports, in whatever form, medium or placement; and

WHEREAS, the TSA has issued in November of 2008 an MOU inviting Airport Authorities to enter into agreements with service providers for the provision of miscellaneous security checkpoint area furnishings and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the parties previously executed a Business Development Agreement dated March 26, 2007 (the "Original Agreement") in order to work collaboratively to install, market and sell advertising in connection with the installation of the SecureTray System® at certain airports; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend and restate the Original Agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereby agree as follows:
