Board of Directors Services Outline Agreement

This Board of Directors Services Outline Agreement (the "Agreement"), dated April 11th, 2015, is entered into between LoveBug Nutrition, Inc., a New York corporation ("the Company"), and [REDACTED] his [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ulos, an individual with a principal place of residence in Zurich, Switzerland ("Director").

The purpose of this Agreement is to set out the terms of a future employment or consulting agreement between the Director and the Company. The Company desires to retain the services of Director for the benefit of the Company and its shareholders.

1. **Title and Scope of Duties.** The Director will hold the titles "Chairman of the Scientific Advisory Board" and member of the "Board of Directors". The duties of the Director shall include:
 - a. Attendance in person (or via telephone for Directors not then present in the U.S.) semiannual Board of Directors meetings;
 - b. Director will be available at dates and times mutually agreeable to Director and the Company, to discuss any matter involving the Company, which involves or may involve issues of which Director has knowledge and cooperate in the review, defense or prosecution of such matters. It is expected that Director's knowledge will be utilized principally for product development, product formulation, marketing or other business disciplines where Director has a deep understanding with respect to the Company's business operations and that such requests may require substantial additional time and efforts in addition to Director's customary service as a member of the Board of Directors;
 - c. Director will make introductions to suppliers, potential suppliers and other counterparties to further the development of the Company. The Company intends to sell overseas (principally in the UK, continental Europe, Australia, and New Zealand). The Director will assist with introductions to international suppliers and distributors to the extent possible;
 - d. Director will notify the Company of any material conflict of interest if the Director believes that he cannot properly fulfill his duties to the Company. The Company acknowledges that the Director has various outside interests and it is not the intention of the Company to limit these activities unless there is an adverse effect on the development of the Company and its future development (including future product launches);
 - e. Director will have a summary bio (including a photograph) and professional qualifications listed on the Company's web site (along with members of the senior management team) and members of the Board of Directors;
 - f. Assist with the recruitment of additional members of the Board of Directors (if so requested by the Company);
